Handling Possible Child or Elderly Abuse

Issued: December 23, 2015

OBJECTIVE:

To set a procedure to handle and report suspected child or elder abuse that is required of public officials per Oregon Revised Statutes 124.050 and 419B.005 any by Oregon Administrative Rule 333-250-0040 3(d) and 3(e).

PROCEDURES:

- 1. If you suspect abuse to a child or elderly person has occurred attempt to transport the victim to the hospital without the possible offender riding along.
- 2. Notify the duty officer as soon as possible.
- 3. Do not put yourself or crew at risk.
- 4. Notify the staff at the hospital and law enforcement of your suspicion of abuse when you arrive at the hospital, and why you suspect abuse.
- 5. If the patient or guardian is unwilling to be transported or allowed to be transported, leave the area, notify law enforcement, the duty officer and wait for their arrival.
- 6. Fill out an incident report and a patient care report on returning to the station.
- 7. Note as a public official you are required by law to report all suspected child or elderly abuse to law enforcement 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
